DECLARATION OF DEREK W. LOESER REGARDING OBJECTIONS TO THE SETTLEMENT, THE PROPOSED PLAN OF ALLOCATION, AND CO-LEAD COUNSEL'S MOTION FOR AN AWARD OF ATTORNEY'S FEES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF LITIGATION EXPENSES

I, Derek W. Loeser declare as follows:

1. I am a partner in the law firm of Keller Rohrback L.L.P. ("Keller Rohrback"), one of the attorneys of record for Plaintiff Louisiana Firefighters and Co-Lead Counsel for the Settlement Class.

2. My firm and I were designated in Paragraph 40 of the Notice of (I) Preliminary Certification of Settlement Class, and Proposed Partial Settlement of Class Action; (II) Settlement Hearing; and (III) Motion for an Award of Attorneys' Fees and Reimbursement of Litigation Expenses, ("Notice"), ECF No. 475-1, as Representative Co-Lead Counsel for receipt of any objections to the Settlement, the Proposed Plan of Allocation or Co-Lead Counsel's motion for an award of attorneys' fees and reimbursement of Litigation Expenses.

3. The Notice required that all Objections be made in writing, and filed with the

Clerk's Office at the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois on or before July 15, 2015. The Notice also required that the papers be served on representative Co-Lead Counsel and Defendants' Counsel so that they would be received on or before July 15, 2015.

4. The Notice also provided in Paragraphs 43-44 that any person wishing to be heard orally at the hearing who had filed and served a timely written objection must also file a notice of appearance with the Clerk's Office and serve it on representative Co-Lead Counsel and Defendants' Counsel on or before July 15, 2015.


5. To date, neither I nor my firm have received service of any papers objecting to the Settlement, the proposed Plan of Allocation or Co-Lead Counsel's motion for an award of attorneys' fees and reimbursement of Litigation Expenses. Nor have we received service of any notice of appearance of anyone intending to be heard orally at the hearing.

6. Counsel for Defendants informed Co-Lead Counsel on July 24, 2015, via email that they have not received service of any papers objecting to the Settlement, the proposed Plan of Allocation or Co-Lead Counsel's motion for an award of attorneys' fees and reimbursement of Litigation Expenses. Nor have they received service of any notice of appearance of anyone intending to be heard orally at the hearing.

7. On July 24, 2015, Keller Rohrback staff called the Clerk's Office at the U.S. District Court, Northern District of Illinois, to inquire whether the Clerk's Office had received any written objections to the settlement, or papers and briefs supporting the objection, and/or whether any notices of appearance had been filed with the Clerk's Office. The Clerk advised Keller Rohrback that any such documents would have been processed and filed on the docket. Accordingly, I checked the Pacer docket and no such objections or notices of appearance have been filed to date.

I declare, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing facts are true and correct.
